

Students Today Alumni Tomorrow (STAT) shall promote further involvement in the CU Denver community by building traditions, seeking links between students and alumni and encouraging pride and spirit within the CU Denver family. STAT will serve as the network and catalyst for student/alumni engagement and become a driving force in the education of their peers on the importance of student/alumni engagement and philanthropic assistance for their alma mater.

Any student enrolled at CU Denver with a GPA of 2.5 or higher may apply to become a member of STAT. Completion of an application and interview are required for membership. Membership in STAT will not be limited based on a person's race, religion, gender, sexual orientation or disability.

All members are required to attend a monthly general assembly meeting as well as a monthly committee meeting. Executive members will also be required to attend an executive board meeting.

All members are required to serve on one of the standing committees (see committee lists for more information): Programs Committee, Community Engagement Committee, Marketing Committee or Fundraising Committee. As such, each member is required to assist with the planning and implementation of at least one program or event relevant to that committee per semester.

Additionally, all members are required to participate in one campus-wide STAT sponsored event per semester. STAT sponsored events include but are not limited to: Move-In Crew, Networking Events, Parent & Family Weekend, Alumni Weekend, Commencement and National Student Engagement & Philanthropy Day.
